- Elect School Community Council Chair and Vice-Chair
 - Nominations for Chair - Ashley Rayback was nominated and elected with a unanimous vote.
 - Nominations vice-chair - Yi Song was nominated and elected with a unanimous vote.
- Review Rules of Conduct Document 2018-2019 SIP Goals -- Review Results
 - Goal 1 Progress: 78.2 % of students made at or above progress on DIBELS at the EOY benchmark. The goal was that 75% of students made at or above progress on DIBELS at the EOY benchmark so we met the goal!
 - Discussed the possibility of getting more members in SCC at PTC
 - Agreed to keep the same rules of conduct from last year with a unanimous vote
- 2019-2020 SIP Review -- Current Goals -- Vote to amend
 - Goal 1 Discussion: Teachers agreed that waiting until mid year to increase this goal would be appropriate
 - Goal 2 Discussion: Teachers agreed to maintaining our 12% increase. So increase the goal from 9% to 12%
 - As a council we voted to amend the goal from 9% to 12%. Voting was unanimous.
