Dear Provo City School District Fifth Grade Parents and Students,

Each summer Provo City School District in conjunction with Provo City Parks and Recreation, provides an Outdoor Education (summer STEM camp) Program. This is a co-curricular program that is an extension of the current fifth grade STEM curriculum. They will spend five days at a camp located up the South Fork of Provo Canyon where they will be involved in activities such as hands on science experiences, arts & crafts, sports & recreation and campfire programs.

4. June 22 - 26 (M-F) Westridge, Amelia Earhart, Timpanogos, Spring Creek
