Game directions: All the children spread out around the classroom and dance while singing the song. One child designated as the "wolf" watches at the side of the room. After the song is sung, the children "ask" the wolf if he is coming. He responds that he is not and gives a reason. The children dance and sing again. After dancing, they ask the wolf once more if he is coming. He says that he is, and chases after the children.

*This is a very dynamic game for Third Graders and Fourth Graders. It fits in well for practicing 'low so' in the Kodály sequence. The Spanish is readily accessible especially since the children are very motivated to learn a Spanish version of this fun chasing game.*
