**II. Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Cristina Bray (PTA Co-President) at 10:06 am.

**III. Moment of Silence:** A moment of silence in honor of Day of Remembrance was observed by participants of the PTA meeting.

**IV. Leadership thought:** A leadership thought was given by Lochsley Allred, Leadership VP, about civic duties and voting.

**V. Teacher Update:** Suzanne Martinez, Teacher VP

- Administered a survey to teachers about what help they need.
- Responses related to requests for food, as well as help with getting children to do school work on CANVAS. Jill said, for privacy reasons, PTA may not call parents.

**VI. Principal Update:** Principal Jill Franklin, Administrative VP, explained some details related to the following:

- Phase 2 coming. Spring Creek has a great ventilation system, eliminates the stale air, teachers can't open the windows. Volunteers are still not permitted. School hours are the same in Phase 2.
- Specialties will get them through CANVAS.
- Dismissal procedure.
- Students who don't get on CANVAS will get a 1 on report card, impacts classes they can sign up for. Parents will be able to see participation grade soon.
- Phone calling those who have no participation 2 weeks in a row. Online learning is not as effective for children in our school.
- School lunch is free for everyone until the end of December or funding runs out.
- Modified evacuation practice on Monday and Tuesday. State has a hold on all drills until February.

- We are set up for the new RAPTOR system. Tentatively planned for after Fall Break. Outer doors will be locked, visitors must be buzzed in, driver's license required, will automatically print you a badge. A few minutes extra to check out your children.

- There are days we have had off previously. Those are now school days.

**VI. Community Outreach Report:** Kimmy Martinez

- Day of caring, Duncan Aviation painted our playground games
- Fliers going out today or Monday for extended day services for academic support.

Students go on Canvas, click a Zoom link for academic support, 2:15-3:45, Monday-Thursday. Students will be able to self-enroll on Canvas. Teachers also refer.

- Still seeking ways to help students with 0 participation on Canvas, reaching out to kids and their families, finding out about the obstacles.

- Trying to offer enrichment, but not compete with day school. Trying to support children and families.

- Social/emotional videos to help with learning.

- We made contact with every single family before school started, because of Kimmy.
