Approve February 26, 2021 Meeting Minutes -- Done via email

SIP Goals:

-Increase the percentage of students K-6 reaching typical, above typical or well above typical progress by 9% based on DIBELS MOY to EOY scores.

-Increase the percentage of the students K-6 reaching benchmark, above benchmark or well above benchmark from DIBELS BOY to EOY by 12%

-Increase by 35 percentage points students scoring in the green from BOY to EOY on the iReady Math diagnostic test

 - to meet the goal 71% at EOY
 - 54% at benchmark or above at BOY
 - 57% at benchmark or above at MOY
 - 66% at EOY
 - iReady Diagnostic Tests

 - 26% Green BOY
 - 40% Green MOY
 - +14 over last year
 - Math
 - 18% Green BOY
 - 33% Green MOY
 - Need +15 to meet the goal
 - 53% at EOY

- Area of Greatest Need -
 - The SCC feels literacy is still the area of greatest need.
 - We will continue to use Acadience to measure literacy goals
 - Goal 1 - Progress goal -9 percentage point increase from MOY to EOY.
 - Goal 2 - Proficiency goal - 12 percentage point increase in students at benchmark, above benchmark, or well above benchmark from BOY to EOY.
 - In the current year, SCC funds have paid for the art teacher and the keyboarding teacher, allowing teachers more collaboration time. We would like to also have additional funds for intervention assistants in the upcoming year. We would like to continue to use \$7,000 for student behavior support. Extra funds could be used for technology, consumables resources that need to be replaced every year
 - Ashley made a motion to approve the plan. Vanessa seconded. The plan was approved by a unanimous vote.
