IV. Principal Update Principal Jill Franklin (Administrative VP)

➤ Governor Cox has lifted the state mask mandate for the last week of school. He is allowing school districts to make the final call. Our school district has chosen to follow that directive, and as such, masks will be optional at Spring Creek during the week of May 24. This will not include kindergarteners, whose last day of school will take place on the 21st.

➤ We are finishing up end-of-level testing. It has been challenging for the students because of the length of time it takes to complete these tests and the added stress it puts on them. Many have had to get used to testing again because we didn't test last year.

➤ We recognize that online schooling has had a negative impact on many of the students' academic progress, and we know that we have work to do. Some students have continued to make progress, which is great!

➤ The Raptor Entry System is going well, for the most part. We have found a flaw in our ventilation system that alters the air pressure in the vestibule (the area between the first and second front doors to the school) where the raptor system is located, and that can cause the doors to not shut as well, causing the raptor system to not always function as intended. We are working on getting that fixed. Most parents report no problems with the Raptor system.

➤ I've been here 5 years, only had to replace 2 teachers before this year, low turn over.

➤ We have school community council openings. Feel free to apply.
