## C. Principal and Administrative Vice President Jill Franklin

1. Reported on the first week back to school for Kindergarteners.

2. Spring Creek has hired five new teachers and is experiencing a transition in this area.

3. Parents were reminded of the informational emails sent out every Sunday night on important school updates for their students.

4. Coronavirus guidelines on the lunch room and birthday treats were discussed. Masks are recommended by the district for students to be worn while in the building. There currently is no mask mandate.

5. Volunteers are allowed in the building this year. Volunteers are encouraged to wear masks.

6. Employment opportunities that are currently available at Spring Creek were presented.

7. Raptor System for visitors was reviewed. If you have previously signed in on the system, you may call ahead and request your badge ahead of time if you're planning on coming to the school. All visitors must come through the front entrance to use the Raptor System.

# D. Community Outreach Kimmy Martinez

3. Classroom coronavirus exposure emails will be sent if an exposure occurs with four recommendations from CDC. If a school reaches 2% infection rate, school will go to a test-to-stay policy. Children can only be sent home if they are actively sick at school.
