1. Early Literacy Acadia scores were shared. The state wants students to be at a 60% proficiency level - Provo School District was at 74%. Our school numbers are normally at a typical level or above for 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, this year we were 75.6%, so well above the district score. Comparable school proficiency scores for RISE from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade students for last year were shared. Our scores were higher in literacy, math, and science than the school whose demographic is most similar to ours. Spring Creek Elementary is double or more than double than the most comparable school. The teachers here are very hard-working!
