### **Approved Minutes**

### **Agenda Items:**

- Safety Review
  - Safety Checks Report
  - Drill Report - unplanned fire drill at 8:45 last Monday. Unforeseen issue with employees who were entering the building and did not know we were evacuating to the field. If this happens again Kimmy will stand near the North entrance and let everyone know.
  - Officer Orgill Report - Possible Gang Activity among 5th/6th graders “GBK”, “GB” tagging or bandanas hanging out of clothing should be reported to Officer Orgill.

  - Discussion on bullying, what bullying is, and how Spring Creek creates a culture of kindness.
- Data Review
  - Growth Measure Assessment Results - we will look at these at the next meeting
    - There was a little hiccup with our reports from the company
- SIP Literacy Goals Draft Review
  - The committee decided to continue to use Acadience for the measure for literacy goals. We will have a progress and proficiency goal, with a 12% increase in both. We will amend goals if necessary.
  - Funds will pay for two collaboration assistants and a behavior interventionist.
  - Additional funds may be used for purchasing iReady Reading for upper grades and for paying for part of an additional teacher to help reduce class size. Jill will bring some numbers to our next meeting so we can have a better idea how far funds will go.

  - Banners - looking into purchasing some banners to hang on the fence.
  - Student Performance for the AfterSchool Theater Club
- **2021-2022 SIP**  
**School Improvement Goals**
  - Increase the percentage of student proficiency in K-6 reaching benchmark or above benchmark from Acadience BOY to EOY by 12 percentage points.
  - Increase the percentage of students K-6 reaching typical, above typical or well above typical progress by 12 percentage points based on Acadience MOY to EOY scores.
  - Double the percentage of students 1st-6th scoring at or above grade level from BOY to EOY on the Math Growth Measure Assessment.

- 50% of ELs will show (adequate .8+ increase in proficiency) growth on their WIDA ACCESS score (This will double the number of students that showed adequate growth in FY21.)
  - 70% of ELs with a FY21 WIDA ACCESS Score of 4.5 or above that are still enrolled at Spring Creek for FY22 ACCESS will score a 5 or higher on their 2021-22 WIDA ACCESS.
  - 3rd-5th grade students will increase from 63% to 69% favorable response in the area of Growth Mindset. [Goal adjusted after review of Fall data.](#)
  - 6th grade will increase from 48% to 54% favorable response in the area of Growth Mindset. [Goal adjusted after review of Fall data.](#)
  - Reduce the number of ODRs submitted for physical aggression. [Difficult goal to measure due to no comparable data.](#)
