Principal and Administrative Vice President Jill Franklin

School Board Representative Jennifer Partridge

1. There is an Open House on May 13 from 1:30 PM – 3:30 PM at the Grandview Learning Center on our future Language Arts curriculum. We are taking parent input on which new curriculum we should use moving forward. Curriculum vendors will also be available for questions. The district has spent considerable time reviewing these potential curriculums.
2. There is a school board meeting next Tuesday night. Teachers of the Year will be recognized, as well as other outstanding employees at the Centennial Middle School auditorium.
3. Tennis courts are being reviewed as a potential part of our new middle school construction plans. City Council was spoken with, and they may be partnering with the district to build city courts as another potential option.

5. Attendance policies will be reverting back to more pre-covid policies. Though they will be reviewed.
6. A date will be set for the Truth in Taxation policy. This policy addresses inflation and paying our teachers and support staff better.
