## Junior Naturalist One session for

6th and 7th graders

Explore nature and become a junior naturalist in this partner camp between the Bean Museum and Thanksgiving Point Institute. Participants (6th and 7th graders) will practice observing, collecting, recording, preparing, identifying, and sharing what they find. This camp is from 9:30 AM until 2:30 PM, Monday through Friday and costs \$295. Parents will need to drop off and pick up their kids at each location. You will need to send a lunch with your child each day of the camp.

## Biology Bootcamp

Two sessions for 2nd - 5th graders

This is a week-long camp that runs from 10 AM - 3 PM Monday - Friday. Children will be transported in vans for fields trips on Thursday and Friday (Hogle Zoo). If your child requires a car seat, you will need to provide that on field trip days. Lunches will not be provided so participants will need to bring their own lunch each day. The cost of the camp is \$200 per child.
