For 3 or more repeating minor incidents to become a major incident the school's behavior intervention expectations need to have been met (e.g., parent phone calls made)		
Cheating/Plagiarism	X	3 or more minor incidents
Defiance	X	3 or more minor incidents
False Information/Lying	X	3 or more minor incidents
Not Working/Off Task	X	3 or more minor incidents
Safety/Endangerment (unsafe behavior)	X	3 or more minor incidents
Theft/Stealing	X	3 or more minor incidents
Vehicle/Bike/Skateboard Misuse	X	3 or more minor incidents
Verbal Aggression (making fun of or yelling at others)	X	3 or more minor incidents
Disruptions	X	Substantial disruption that prevents teaching/learning from happening or 3 or more minor incidents
Left School/Class Without Permission	Left Class	Left School or 3 or more minor incidents
Inappropriate Tech Use (Misuse of computers, email, or the internet)	Off-task	Accessing pornography, hacking, or 3 or more minor incidents
Phone Violation	During recess or lunch	During class or 3 or more minor incidents
Property Destruction	X	Vandalism or 3 or more minor incidents
Swearing/Profanity	X	The 'f' word or 3 or more minor incidents

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Threat/Intimidation	X	Threat of killing another person or 3 or more minor incidents
