Need to approve last month's minutes - minutes are approved as written - there were no changes.

- Digital Citizenship Presentation by JP Pontious Network Administrator for Provo City School District
 - a. ContentKeeper is our district filter will block all harmful sites known to filter. Also blocks unknown sites
 - b. Chromebooks (Bark.us) on-site filter
 - c. Blocksi is also used to manage classroom Chromebooks , also available off campus.
 - d. Different settings for different grade levels/curfews assigned
 - e. Youtube and Google Images go to restricted more and Safe Search mode
 - f. Most schools use BeNetPositive.org (Spring Creek had NetSmartz come last year.)
 - g. Schools will provide training on web safety within 45 days of school starting
 - h. District uses E-rate funding to keep infrastructure up to date and secure.
- 2. Ruth Ann will look into BeNetPostive, NetSmartz has also reached out to us this year. Ruth Ann will report back about pricing and information in January.

- 3. Presentation of Data from Parent Input Survey
 - a. 76 responses in English and 11 responses in Spanish responses from each classroom
 - b. Discussion items:
 - Have a notice at the top of the email to scroll down for Spanish. Be mindful to have a Spanish speaker read over the DeepL translation to ensure it makes sense and is in context.
 - ii. Is there a way to select a different language for our website similar to what the district website does? (Question for Caleb)
 - iii. May want to consider rewording the question about being able to check your child's academic work completion. 6th Grade uses PowerSchool, but this is tricky for younger grade levels.
 - iv. Parents want family centered activities followed by student performances (English) Academic Training Literacy was number one for Spanish responses.
